### Close to \$200,000 spent on veterinary care since July 2023

The above number represents the cost of caring for over 30 dogs with special needs.

Besides standard veterinary care our rescues will always have the need for specialty care including orthopedics, internists, ophthalmologists, surgeons, neurologists, and physical therapists.

#### This event is crucial to re-establishing our financial trajectory.

Let us introduce Marcus, one of our newest rescues that needed our voice, our time, and our doctors.

Marcus, just a pup at 5.5 months old, was found by a police officer in a roadside ditch in rural Georgia- Severely injured, abandoned, cold, wet and in unimaginable pain. Marcus was rushed to a local veterinary hospital where it was discovered he had suffered 3 severely broken legs; one fracture was exposed through his skin. His injuries made him a candidate for euthanasia.

When one of our inter-state partners contacted us with his story, we sprang into action! As soon as we saw his picture and videos, it was obvious that his spirit was not broken. We had him transported to the Charleston Veterinary Referral Hospital where we advocated for surgery to repair his legs. We were hopeful he would be able to walk again. Marcus is now 4 weeks post-op, and he is WALKING and happy to be with people that care about him and his welfare.

His estimated rehabilitation cos is *nearly \$20,000* and as with all our stories, we rely on donor support to cultivate these successful endings.

Because of these efforts that were tailored to his needs, Marcus defied the odds. His recouperation is still ongoing but he is happy, walking and in a safe place.

His final step will be to find a home suitable for his needs. Which we are certain will happen soon!
